<u>Poll Site Ballots:</u> The Village of Summit has one polling location (Village Hall) offering ballots to registered voters on <u>Election Day (November 8, 2016).</u> We are open 13 hours from 7:00 am to 8:00 pm. We anticipate Election Day to have a high turn-out and we anticipate lines! Great for the voter who enjoys seeing our democracy in action!

## The Ballot that Fits your Timeline (evenings or weekends, you decide)!

**Mail Ballots:** This option is best for voters who are unable to vote on Election Day, those who have trouble waiting in lines, or just can't get to Village Hall during In-Person voting hours. Upon receiving your fax, email or written request, your ballot will be mailed to the address of your choice within one business day. Be sure to attach a copy of your Photo ID along with your request for a ballot. Voted ballots must be returned by no later than 8 pm on Election Day!

Requests for mailed ballots are already being accepted and processed!

## In-person Absentee Voting at Village Hall

**In-Person Absentee Ballots:** This option is available to voters who are unable or unwilling to vote at their polling location on Election Day and/or those who prefer not to receive a mail ballot. Please be aware: it is likely there will be lines!
